

Library at Home Activity – Wood Round Owl



Connect. Create. Explore.

Materials Needed:

- One large wooden slab (approx. 12" round)
 - One large metal spoon
 - Two large metal forks
 - Three sets of circular lids of different sizes
 - Hot glue gun and glue sticks
 - A tree branch
- Optional:
- Feathers
 - Googly eyes

Step 1.

Layer your lids from largest to smallest to make the eyes of your owl. If you have googly eyes, you can use them in place of the smallest lid size. Bottle caps or a sharpie could work too! Glue the lids together to make sure they stay in place.



Step 2:

Place the spoon close to the top middle of your wooden slab with the bowl facing the wood.



Step 3.

Place the eyes on either side of the spoon. Once you are happy with the placement, place glue on the handle of the spoon. Press down gently to ensure a good seal on the spoon and then glue down the eyes.



Step 4.

Glue your tree branch to the bottom of the slab.



Step 5.

Place the two forks at the bottom of the slab to look like legs. Glue them upside down so that the tines point towards the back.



Step 6.

This step is optional, but fun! Glue feathers to your owl to add your own unique spin.



Step 7.

Enjoy your newest creation!
