

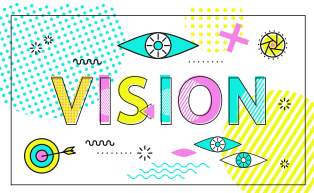

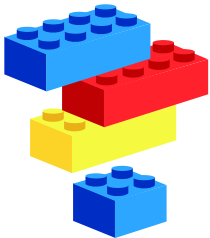


Freedom to Read Party!

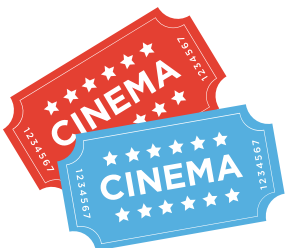


Maple Syrup Storytime
