Conducted community outreach and participated in over thirty (30) community events. Created a User Engagement Survey to seek feedback from residents of SDG Counties. SDG Library Adds Accessibility Policy

The Board reviewed and approved SDG Library's proposed Accessibility Policy. The policy, the first of its kind, emphasizes the Library's commitment to creating inclusive, equitable, and accessible spaces for all members of our community.

Guided by our mission and values, the policy outlines our efforts to provide accessible formats, assistive technologies and services, that will help foster independence and inclusion for people with disabilities.



One (1) in four (4) Canadians aged fifteen (15) years and older have one or more disabilities that limit them in their daily activities. This policy is an essential step toward ensuring that our collections, programs, and services meet diverse needs.
